PAYMENTS TO PAC CASUAL REVENUE

Work berth, extra slip days and casual moorings bookings are payable by EFT into our NAB account and filling out a casual revenue card located in the slip room. These cards must be deposited into the letterbox in the office door upstairs. Without the cards we cannot process your payment. When depositing the fee into the NAB you must be clearly identified in the reference box in the EFT. These cards become part of the financial records of the club. Note! If you exceed your slip days (Slip No 1, 3 Days. Slip No 2, 4 days) it is your responsibility to pay for the excess days through the casual revenue system. INVOICES All other payments require an invoice to be raised. For instance, if you want to join a facilities wait list, lease a dinghy rack, or pay annual fees you must be issued with an invoice. This is essential to leave a clear auditor trail. When you are making a payment, please, place your surname and invoice number in the reference box.
